Clinical Dietitian opportunity at the Kelowna General Hospital (KGH) in Kelowna, B.C. This is a term specific part-time 0.6fte (22.5 hours per week) position until May 30, 2025. This position works 08:00-16:00 on Mondays, Wednesday and Fridays. This position is primarily assigned to acute medical and rehabilitation units, and requires Restricted Activities A, B and C.

About the job

Utilizing clinical techniques and knowledge, the Dietitian provides nutrition services through: nutrition assessment; care planning and charting; intervention, goal setting and monitoring; counseling and education programs; consults and communicates with the multidisciplinary care teams; acts as a resource to other health professionals and communities within Interior Health.

The Dietitian provides input to the Practice Leader or designate by participating in the development of nutrition practice guidelines and procedures; research and continuous quality improvement initiatives for the facility and program.

The Dietitian liaises and advises food service staff on patient/client/resident care issues and menu development.

Qualifications

- · Baccalaureate degree in nutrition and dietetics.
- $\cdot \text{Successful completion of an accredited hospital based dietetic internship program (or equivalent acceptable to the facility)}.$
- Full registration as a Registered Dietitian with the College of Health and Care Professionals of British Columbia (CHCPBC) with Restricted Activities A, B and C.
- \cdot One year of clinical nutrition experience in a health care environment preferred. New grads are welcome.
