Aims and expectations: A mentor supports and encourages young people to participate in activities across the session. They may also prepare learning resources or activities for sessions.

We provide free resources such as project guides, certificates, and posters, and we offer support through online workshops, community events and ongoing guidance.

Tasks:

- Welcome attendees as they arrive at the sessions
- Encourage young people to participate in session activities
- Help to plan and prepare resources ahead of club sessions
- Provide support to young people who are new to coding
- Provide technical guidance to help young people progress with their projects
- Help to set up technical equipment before sessions

All volunteers must attend mandatory safeguarding training and obtain a clear background check. Digital Moment will cover the cost of the background check.
